

 - **The Psychological Profiles of Left-wing Authoritarians (Master's Thesis):** We investigated the relationship between COVID-19 threat perception and left-wing authoritarianism in Study 1, and left-wing authoritarianism's association with moral behaviors using incentivized economic games in Study 2. I am currently writing the first draft for scholarly publication.

 - Understanding Left-wing Authoritarianism in Turkey: With three studies, we adapted two prominent left-wing authoritarianism scales into Turkish and investigated the relationship between left-wing authoritarianism and cognitive style measurements such as cognitive reflection and actively open-minded thinking.  - Cognitive Reflection and Religiosity: Testing Two Models (*Project funded* by Templeton Religion Trust): I am currently finalizing the first draft of a paper as the first author where we tested the relationship between reflection and religious belief with a matched sample of believers and non-believers using an array of cognitive style measurements.

 - An Investigation of Religious Priming Techniques (Project funded by Templeton Religion Trust): I am going to be the first author of this project where we experimentally investigated the effectiveness of both new and existing religious priming techniques in the literature.
 - Art, Empathy, and Justice (Project funded by Templeton Religion Trust): We tried to replicate the effect of religious and secular music on generosity (using the dictator game) and its interaction with empathy. I will write the manuscript of this study for scholarly publication.

(Government Funded Research Project - TÜBİTAK): In this project we investigate the influences of resource scarcity in prosocial decision-making contexts and its interactions with intuitive and reflective cognitive styles. We are also currently developing a new priming technique to activate a resource scarcity mindset. I am actively helping progress the project with other lab members.

- Distinguishing the Psychological Underpinnings of Threat Types: In this project, we are investigating how the psychological representations of different types of threat such as death and resource scarcity differ using network and content analysis methods. I am an active research assistant in this project.
